Plant Type: Bulb Dies back in winter
Flower Color: Blue-purple
Flowering Time: April to May
Height: 1-1.5 feet
Width: 1 feet
Exposure: Sun-part shade
Water Req.: Moist - wetland plant. Do not allow to dry out.
Habitat Value: Native Bees

Comments and Maintenance:

Beautiful bulb for a naturally wet pond, swale or near downspout.
Plant 4-5" deep and 6-12" apart.
