Plant Type:	Shrub	Evergreen
Flower Color:	White	
Flowering Time:	May to July	
Height:	5-12 feet	
Width:	5 feet	
Exposure:	Sun-light shade	
Water Req.:	Occasional - once a month or so, depending on temperatures and wind.	
Habitat Value:	Pollinators	

Comments and Maintenance:

This species is now rare in the wild. You can help save it by planting in your garden. Beautiful 2" flowers. No special treatment is needed to sprout the seed. Sow 3-4 seed a in pot in early winter on good potting media, cover with media, put in cool shady spot. Transplant to larger pot when 2-4 true leaves. Add to garden when roots have filled the pot, usually the next fall.
