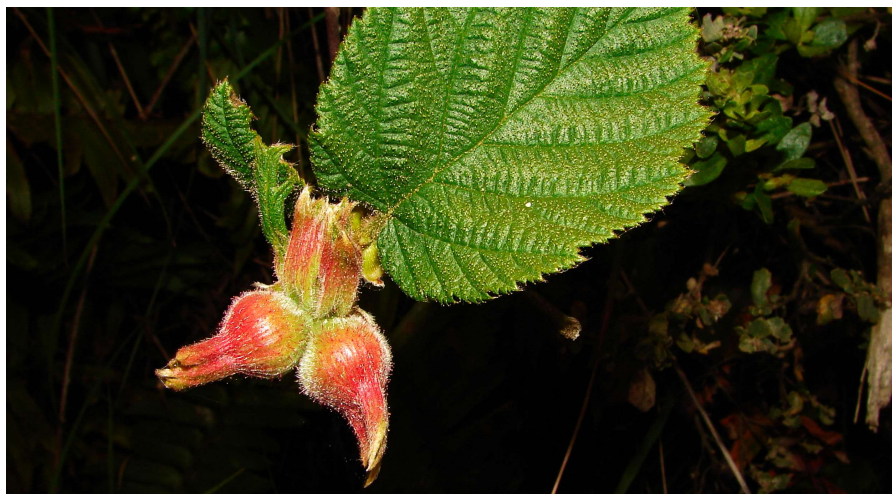


Hazelnut

Comments and Maintenance:

Edible nuts; good shrub to plant under large trees like oaks; low maintenance - prune dead wood; decorative, dangling catkins provide winter interest in the garden; leaves provide fall color
