Plant Type: Perennial Deciduous
Flower Color: Pink
Flowering Time: March to July
Height: .5 feet
Width: 1-1.5 feet
Exposure: Shade
Water Req.: Moderate -every 2-3 weeks or when top 3-4" of soil is dry.
Habitat Value: Bees, hummingbirds

Comments and Maintenance:

Fall and winter dormant perennial. Pink heart-shaped flowers held over lacey fern-like leaves. Spreads underground to new areas of the garden.
