Plant Type:	Perennial	Evergreen
Flower Color:	cream to yellow	
Flowering Time:	March to May	
Height:	1	feet
Width:	1	feet
Exposure:	Sun-light shade	
Water Req.:	Occasional - once a month or so, depending on temperatures and wind.	
Habitat Value:	Pollinators, butterflies	

Comments and Maintenance:

Lovely cream-colored, fragrant flowers in early to midspring. Native to coastal bluffs. It should have reasonably good drainage. Easy to grow, and makes a good container plant.
