Plant Type:	Shrub	Evergreen
Flower Color:	Yellow	
Flowering Time:	April to July	
Height:	4-6 feet	
Width:	4-8 feet	
Exposure:	Sun-light shade	
Water Req.:	Occasional - once a month or so, depending on temperatures and wind.	
Habitat Value:	Birds	

Comments and Maintenance:

Shorter and more compact than the wild coffeeberry. Has many small yellow flowers attract a range of pollinators. Berries are attractive (but not edible for humans) turning from red to purple to black, and are food for small mammals and birds. Host plant for the pale swallowtail butterfly. Drought tolerant but appreciates occasional summer water.
