Water Req.:	Dry - no water once established, unless severe drought

Comments and Maintenance:

Spectacular cup-shaped golden yellow flowers with orange backs bloom in late spring. A great plant for slopes or other well-drained sites. Once established flannel bush is completely drought tolerant and will accept summer water only where drainage is excellent. This variety is the lowest-growing of the fremontias.
