Gilia tricolor - Seed

Plant Type: Annual
Flower Color: Blue-light
Flowering Time: April to August
Height: 0.5-1.5 feet
Width: 0.5 feet
Exposure: Sun-light shade
Water Req.: Moderate - every 3-4 weeks or when top 3-4" of soil is dry.
Habitat Value: Bees -native

Comments and Maintenance:

Native Sonoma County wildflower. Forms lovely carpets of blue. Unique blue pollen. Sow on ground in fall. Cover with potting media or sifted compost.
