Plant Type:	Bulb	Evergreen
Flower Color:	Many	
Flowering Time:	March to April	
Height:	1.5 feet	
Width:	2 feet	
Exposure:	Sun-part shade	
Water Req.:	Occasional - once a month or so, depending on weather.	
Habitat Value:	Pollinators	

Comments and Maintenance:

Seeds from multi color native iris. From seed will mostly be blue. Soak seed overnight. Drain and put in ziploc type bag with a little potting media. Put in refrigerator for 2 months. Remove and sow on 4" pots. Plant after 2 years when bulb like structure is at least 1/2" in diameter.
