*Lilium humboldtii* - Seed

Plant Type:	Bulb	Dies back in winter
Flower Color:	Orange	
Flowering Time:	April to July	
Height:	2-4 feet	
Width:	1-1.5 feet	
Exposure:	Sun-part shade	
Water Req.:	Moderate - every 2-3 weeks or when top 3-4" of soil is dry.	
Habitat Value:	Pollinators	

Comments and Maintenance:

North Coastal lily, do not plant near Pitkin or Cunningham Marsh- may hybridize with our rare Pitkin lily. Soak seed overnight. Drain and put in ziploc bag with perlite. Put in refrigerator 60 days. Sow 4-5 seed on 4" pot. Grow 1.5-2 years until bulb is at least 1/2" in diameter. Then plant in garden.
