Water Req.:	Moderate -every 2-3 weeks or when top 3-4" of soil is dry.	
Habitat Value:	Hummingbirds, birds	

Comments and Maintenance:

This vine looks great climbing up shrubs in the landscape. In addition to attracting hummingbirds, it is not aggressive and won't smother the plant supporting it. It has attractive clusters of orange trumpet shaped flowers. Fruits provide food for birds.
