Habitat Value: Hummingbirds, butterflies, bees

Comments and Maintenance:

Small shrubby plant, covered with large, showy flowers all summer long. Flowers attract bees, butterflies, as well as hummingbirds. Mimulus should be pinched back in the fall/winter, to encourage new growth and flowers. Plants will not recover from hard pruning. Deer resistant. This variety will tolerate more shade than the others, and still bloom freely.
