Exposure:	Sun-part shade	
Water Req.:	Occasional - once a month or so, depending on temperatures and wind.	
Habitat Value:	Hummingbirds, butterflies, bees	

Comments and Maintenance:

Small shrubby plant, covered with showy flowers all summer long. Flowers attract bees, butterflies, as well as hummingbirds. This Mimulus should be trimmed annually. Deer resistant. This variety has sparser foliage than others, and is the straight species from our local hillsides.
