Plant Type:	Perennial	dies back each year
Flower Color:	Red	
Flowering Time:	May to September	
Height:	2 feet	02
Width:	1.5 feet	
Exposure:	Sun-part shade	
Water Req.:	Moist - do not allow soil to become completely dry.	
Habitat Value:	Hummingbirds, butterflies, bees	

Comments and Maintenance:

Small shrubby plant, covered with large, showy flowers all summer long. Flowers attract bees, butterflies, as well as hummingbirds. Grows happily along sunny creeks, where it reseeds freely.
