### Comments and Maintenance:

Good for a dry sunny site; low maintenance groundcover with minty leaves. Large purple blooms attract bees and butterflies. Beautiful in mass when planted in borders, raised beds, or in containers. Common name is Russian River Coyote Mint. Deer resistant.
