Flower Color:	Pink	
Flowering Time:	February to April	
Height:	1-1.5 feet	03
Width:	0.5 feet	
Exposure:	Sun-part shade	
Water Req.:	Moderate - every 3-4 weeks or when top 3-4" of soil is dry.	
Habitat Value:	Pollinators	

### Comments and Maintenance:

Native to Sonoma Co. Lovely early spring wildflower that comes back each year. Sprinkle seed on ground in fall. Cover with potting media or sifted compost.
