Plant Type: Perennial Dies back in winter  
Flower Color: Yellow  
Flowering Time: February to May  
Height: 0.5-1 feet  
Width: 1 feet  
Exposure: Sun  
Water Req.: Moderate - every 2-3 weeks or when top 3-4" of soil is dry.  
Habitat Value: Pollinators

Comments and Maintenance:

Sonoma County native wildflower that comes back from the roots each year. Lovely shiny cheerful yellow flowers. Sow on ground in fall. Cover lightly with potting media or sifted compost.
