Comments and Maintenance:

Need a beautiful screening/hedgerow plant or to prevent erosion on a hillside? This thicket forming shrub is a great choice. Single pink blossoms occur on multiple stems that spread with underground stems. Nice deep red rosehips in the late fall and winter add color to your winter garden. Prune back heavily in the winter for more blooms.
