Comments and Maintenance:

Sonoma County native bulb-type plant. Soak seed overnight. Drain and put in ziploc bag with equal volume of perlite. Put in refrigerator for 60 days. Take out and sow 4-5 seed on a 4" pot. Leave in pot for 1.5-2 years until bulb is at least 1/2" in diameter or it blooms in pot. Plant in garden in late fall.
