*Solidago velutina ssp. californica*

Plant Type: Perennial Dies back in winter  
Flower Color: Yellow  
Flowering Time: July to September  
Height: 3 feet  
Width: 1.5 feet  
Exposure: Sun  
Water Req.: Occasional - once a month or so, depending on temperatures and wind.  
Habitat Value: Pollinators

Comments and Maintenance:

This great perennial provides late summer bloom and nectar for bees and butterflies. Will spread some by underground stems, especially with more water. Keep old flowers pruned off for continuous blooming. This plant does not induce allergies.
