

Woolly Blue-Curls
Trichostema lanatum

Plant Type:	Shrub	Evergreen
Flower Color:	Blue-purple	
Flowering Time:	April to November	
Height:	4	feet
Width:	4	feet
Exposure:	Sun	
Water Req.:	Dry - no water once established, unless severe drought	
Habitat Value:	Hummingbirds	

Comments and Maintenance:

Tubular 2 lipped blue flowers make this very drought tolerant shrub a winner. Plant in dry, well-drained area. No summer water once established! Can be shaped by pinching back stems. Needs good drainage. Not good in clay soil. Keep bark mulch away from stems. Plant a little high. After 4-5 years it may begin to decline-remove and replace-does not take to pruning.
