Plant Type:	Perennial	Evergreen
Flower Color:	Pale apricot orang	
Flowering Time:	May to September	
Height:	2	feet
Width:	3	feet
Exposure:	Sun-part shade	
Water Req.:	Moderate-every 3-4 weeks or when top 3-4" of soil is dry	
Habitat Value:	Nectar and larval food source	

Comments and Maintenance:

Quite floriferous hybrid monkey flower, stays in a tidy mound. Drought tolerant with light shade, preferring a heavy soak or two in extensive drought years. Very attractive to hummingbirds.
