Heracleum maximum

Plant Type: Perennial Semi-evergreen
Flower Color: White
Flowering Time: February to April
Height: 5 feet
Width: 2 feet
Exposure: Sun-Light shade
Water Req.: Moist - do not allow soil to become completely dry.
Habitat Value: Pollinators

Comments and Maintenance:

For a bold statement in the early spring, the huge white flower head of cow parsnip is perfect. Large deep green leaves at the base are a lovely contrast. It does need constant moisture.
